- $\circ$  Are there supports we could provide to make it a better fit?
- $\circ$  Can we modify the intervention/strategy to make it a better fit?

If the answer to any of these questions is "maybe" or "no":

5) Are the necessary resources (time, staff, administrative support) available?

4) Do you have the skills needed to implement the intervention?

3) Is this intervention consistent with your values as an educator?

- Do you believe this intervention will be effective for the student?
  - 1) Is this intervention feasible for you to implement?

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### **Meeting Purpose & Norms**

## **Meeting Goals**

Work together using FBA information to develop a Behavior Intervention Plan that will support the student to be successful in school behaviorally, socially and academically.

## **Meeting Expectations/Norms**

- 1) Believe and commit to supporting the student
- 2) Keep focus on Benefit to the student
  - No blaming the student or family
- Focus on Interventions & what we can control
  - Limit discussion on diagnoses, medications
- 4) Speak up if you have concerns about Interventions
